FACT CHECK

FACT: Approximately 80% of incarcerations are related to substance use or behavior related to such use.

FACT: Well over 100,000 Americans are dying each year from substance overdoses. It is the leading cause of injury-related preventable death in the U.S.

FACT: In the last 15 years, more Americans have died from drug overdose than have perished in all wars in our history combined.

FACT: An estimated \$50 billion is lost when people who abuse substances pursue criminal careers rather than enter the labor force.
